APPLICATION FOR RESIDENTS PERMIT

A Residents Permit can only be issued to :

- (a) A resident who is on the Register of Electors at the address he/she is applying for the permit.
- (b) The resident must be the registered owner of the vehicle and the vehicle must be registered at the address stated on the application form for a residents permit.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED

- (1) Certificate of Registration & Licensing for the vehicle
- (2) Certificate of Insurance (not Insurance Disc)
- (3) **Two** recent Utility Bills issued in the name of the applicant at the address for which the residents permit is requested.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

“Owner” means a resident by whom a vehicle is habitually kept and used.

“Resident” means a person whose normal residence is at a premises situated in a street containing a disc parking place.

“Valid Residents Parking Disc” means a residents parking disc which relates to a particular street or streets and to a period which has not expired and which is issued by the local authority in whose functional area the vehicle on which on which the disc is displayed is parked.

“Vehicle” means a private motor car, a station wagon or a passenger vehicle having accommodation for not more than seven passengers excluding the driver.

The display of a valid resident’s parking disc on the vehicle in respect of which the disc was issued, shall permit the owner of the vehicle (or any person using it with his consent) to park it without limitation as to time in a disc parking place in a street to which the disc relates.

A valid resident’s parking disc shall be so displayed in the interior of the vehicle in respect of which it is issued that it can be read from outside the vehicle.

Where a vehicle displaying a valid resident’s parking disc is displayed in a disc parking place a person shall not interfere with the disc.

The fee for a resident’s parking disc shall be €12.70

A resident’s parking disc shall be issued for one year from the date of issue.

Where during the period to which a resident’s parking disc relates, the resident to whom it is issued ceases to reside at the address specified on the disc or ceases to be an owner by disposing of the vehicle to which the disc relates, he shall return it (addressed to the person a copy of whose signature appears on it) to the local authority by whom the disc was issued.

Where, during the period to which a resident’s parking disc relates, the resident to whom it is issued disposes of the vehicle to which the disc relates and substitutes another vehicle for the disposed of, he shall return the disc to Thurles Town Council, when upon payment of the current fee by the resident, a new disc in respect of that vehicle shall be issued to the resident, and such new disc shall be valid for the period specified.
